



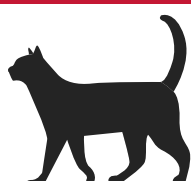

ADVANCED MEDICAL CARE

In 2019, we paid for advanced medical care for shelter animals whose lives might have ended prematurely without it.

\$19,022 helped **30 dogs** (\$634/dog)

\$40,472 helped **177 cats** (\$228/cat)



SPAY AND NEUTER

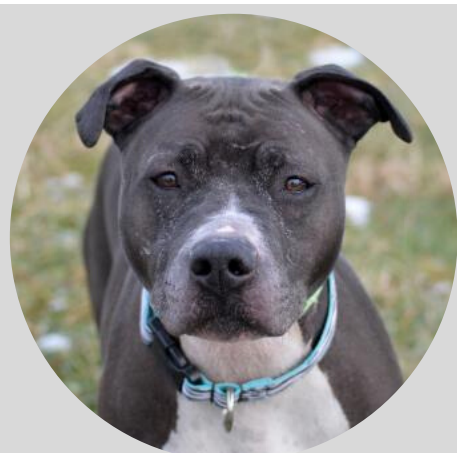
We focused on preventing cats and dogs from entering the shelter by facilitating low-cost spay/neuter clinics and partially funding surgery costs for county residents.

We spent **\$51,962** to fix over **1,438** cats and pit bull-type dogs.

VOLUNTEERS

272 volunteers provided **33,623 hours** helping cats and dogs in our community.

Our volunteers assisted caregivers through trap-neuter-return (TNR) of **245 community cats**.



DONORS

Because of **1,425 generous donors** and fundraising events, our revenue was **\$249,555**.

SIGNATURE EVENTS

Friends hosted two major events in 2019:

RAINING CATS AND DOGS

We held our annual pet festival and open house at the county shelter in April. **2,000+ people** enjoyed vendor exhibits, contests, music and more.

PAW PRINTS 5K

We held our annual 5K and 1-miler in September. **500+ attendees** enjoyed a beautiful morning at Smithville Park as we raised a total of **\$34,455** for the animals.
