Scheduling Spay/Neuter for your Foster

Requirements for Spay/Neuter:

- Cat must be 2 pounds or more
- Cat must have at least 1 injectable distemper vaccinations, with at least 1 week between 2nd vacc and clinic
- Cat must be healthy and not on medication

Contact the shelter with the following details:

- Cat's Name and ID
- Sex and current weight

Fosters are required to drop their foster cats off on the morning of surgery at 8:30 AM or the day before if necessary. Foster cats must fast prior to surgery, so do not give food past 12 AM the night of.

Routine Medical Visitation Hours at BCAS:

- Always call the shelter at 609-265-5073 before coming. Call until someone picks up; do not leave a message on the machine. Explain your situation and wait for instructions.
 - Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday, Saturday & Sunday 10am-1pm
 - Thursday 4:30-6:30pm
 - Holidays & Shelter Closure Days: NO availability

For Emergency Situations:

- Call the shelter between 9 AM - 4 PM on any day (9 AM - 7 PM on Thurs) at 609-265-5073. Call until somebody picks up, and do not leave a message on the machine. Explain that you believe you have an urgent situation, describe the details, and wait for advice / instructions.
- Call Mandy at 609-534-3394 when the shelter is closed or if the shelter can not assist you directly. Please know that we will do our best to respond ASAP, but we may not be able to respond immediately.

Visits to Outside Veterinarians:

- Any visits to outside vets must be pre-approved unless you are willing to pay for the vet care yourself.
- For approved visits, please retain the invoice and send to the Cat Foster Team for billing.
- For any visit, please make sure to ask for a copy of the medical records from the vet and send them to the Cat Foster Team to be included with your cat's original shelter paperwork.
