## **ADVANCED MEDICAL CARE**

In 2018, we paid for advanced medical care for cats and dogs. Without this care, the lives of these animals may have ended prematurely.

- \$39,725 to help **52 dogs (**\$764/dog)
- \$37,322 to help **124 cats (**\$301/cat)





## **SPAY AND NEUTER**

Friends is focused on preventing cats and dogs from entering the shelter by facilitating spay/neuter clinics and partially funding surgery costs for county residents.

In 2018, we spent approximately \$60,000 to help fix over **1,850 cats & dogs**.


### VOLUNTEERS

**330 volunteers** provided **38,116 hours** helping cats & dogs in our community.

#### Our trap-neuter-return (TNR)

volunteers assisted caregivers through TNR of over **625 community cats**.





### DONORS

We had **1,370 active donors** in 2018. Through generous donors and fundraising events our revenue was \$235,412.

### SIGNATURE EVENTS

Friends hosted two major events in 2018:

#### **Raining Cats and Dogs**

Raining Cats and Dogs Pet Festival in April had about **2,000 attendees** visit the shelter ground. Vendor exhibits, music and more made for a great day.

#### **Paw Prints 5K**

In September we held Paw Prints 5K and 1-miler. Over **500 attendees** enjoyed a beautiful morning running/walking through Smithville Park as we raised over **\$36,000** for the animals.
