ADVANCED MEDICAL CARE

In 2020, we paid for advanced medical care for shelter animals whose lives might have ended prematurely without it.

\$16,766 Helped 28 dogs \$598/dog) \$47,493 Helped 128 cats (\$371/cat)

SPAY AND NEUTER

We focused on preventing cats and dogs from entering the shelter by facilitating low-cost spay/neuter clinics and partially funding surgery costs for county residents.

We spent **\$43,837** to fix over **1,687** cats and pit bull type dogs

VOLUNTEERS

347 volunteers provided 31,087 hours helping cats and dogs in our community.

Our volunteers assisted caregivers through trap-neuter-return (TNR) of **498 community cats**.






DONORS

Because of **1,608 generous donors** and fundraising events, our revenue was **\$244,261**.

FOOD PANTRIES

Thanks to generous donors, we were able to supply \$7,359 of dog and cat food to local pantries, for those struggling to feed their animals during Covid.
